The Year in EPIDEMIOLOGY

Our 2011 calendar of key events taking place in Epidemiology next year contains 175 listings. As usual, it contains a wide variety of offerings, including numerous short courses, a dozen or so summer programs, and multiple meetings for professional organizations of epidemiologists and public health professionals.

Of special note, there will be TWO World Congresses of Epidemiology in 2011. The first will take place in June in Montreal, Canada and is the North American Congress, the third one of its kind to bring together key epidemiology associations in North America. The second will take place in Edinburgh Scotland in August and is sponsored by the International Epidemiological Association. Be sure to follow the preparations and announcements for the Congresses to be covered in detail in The Epidemiology Monitor starting this month with a special description of the themes for the Congress in Scotland (see page 20). Deadlines for abstracts are January 21, 2011 for the Scotland Congress and February 5, 2011 for the Montreal Congress.

Each Congress is being held in conjunction with other local events that will be of broad interest. For example, the Edinburgh International Festival will take place from August 12 starting just after the Epidemiology Congress. In Canada, the Montreal International Jazz Festival in that city will begin immediately after the Congress.

Under this theme, speakers have already been invited to discuss the epidemiology of ageing, the epidemiology of tobacco and related diseases, and the Chinese Biobank Project.

D. Neglected Conditions

Authors are encouraged to categorize their proposed presentations in this area if the disease has not been well studied or has received little attention.

E. Epidemiology and Policy

This is a broad topic area and examples of presentations to be made in the plenary sessions on this theme are those by Robert Beaglehole on the relevance of epidemiology for policy, by Sally MacIntyre on evidence and policy, and by Cesar Victora on the partnership between epidemiology and public health in S. America.

Note: Authors whose abstracts do not conform to one of these themes are able to classify their presentation as belonging to an OTHER category.
