If It Paws The Court Handlers assist litigants through the court process by including their professionally-trained dogs in their work. If It Paws The Court Dogs primarily provide comfort by alleviating anxiety, stress and providing a safe focus for the parties and children. Dogs and their Attorney-Handlers work in offices, alternative dispute resolution facilities, on home visits, interviews, and in the courtrooms.

If It Paws the Court Dogs are frequently older and have proven their ability to relate well with all types of individuals, especially children, and their capacity to remain stationary for extended periods of time. While it is generally not required, If It Paws the Court Dogs are expected to patiently attend their Handlers in a courthouse setting for up to eight (8) hours.

If It Paws the Court Handlers are professionals who work within the family law system. Many are attorneys, Guardian ad Litems, psychologists, and professional counselors. Although trained as a professional working dog, **If It Paws The Court** Dogs are the Handler's personal pet.
