Please join us for the 12th Annual National Intercollegiate Mediation Tournament, November 1-3, 2012 at Brenau University, Gainesville, Georgia. There are five reasons why you should attend:

1. It introduces students to mediation and peacemaking, which has become the primary means to resolve disputes in the United States.
2. It takes only 3 interested students to make up a team and participate.
3. Some of the top mediators in the nation provide one and one-half days of training so that students with little or no exposure can participate and be comfortable doing so.
4. The tournament is low key and designed to encourage students to share ideas and experiences with students from around the country. It does, however, provide All American designation for top participants.
5. The eight teams making the finals will be invited to attend the International Law School Mediation Tournament being held in London or Dubai, March 2013.

If you are interested in attending law school, participation in the tournament is a must. Legal disputes today are not decided in the courts, but at mediation tables. Learning what a mediator does and how one can become a peacemaker is an educational experience in itself and will put you just that much further ahead in law school.

At the International Law School Mediation tournament held at Loyola University Chicago School of Law this past March 2012, thirty schools and forty-six teams participated from around the world including teams from India, Germany, the United Kingdom, Northern Ireland, and Canada.
